




Q2 Gender?





Q3 Age range?





Q4 The State or Territory in which you currently live?





Q5 How would you describe the area you live in?







Q7 Do you support the establishment of comprehensive pill testing programs at music events including dance festivals and nightclubs?









Q10 Do you support the establishment of needle and syringe programs in prisons?





Q11 Do you support the introduction of prescribed heroin (also known as heroin assisted treatment)?










